Where the Romans already grew and pressed wine over 2.000 years ago, the winegrowers live on the East Styrian Roman Wine Road with their typical wine taverns, so called "Buschenschanken" today. A typical tony tavern snack combines diverse aromas that let easily move up your mouth angles. In these Buschenschanken taverns you can order Ruckwurst, Römische Beizen (cabbage meat), Scharfsalat and house brine wrangle on the wooden cutting board together with something to spread. Don't forget the very typical pumpkin seed oil salad with pumpkin beans, and also try the very crispy farmer's bread. Finally smile at your delicious wine glass and enjoy your life - get well and cheer!

How can you find these typical Buschenschank taverns?

You can easily find opened Buschenschank taverns when you look at bushes along the road. Another option is to ask locals about it, everyone knows the word "Buschenschank" very well in East Styria.
